

Students can enter the Trades Norwest program in FLICAN SENIOR COLLEGE Year 12 and follow a Pathways Program.

Year 12 (Note: Normal College fees apply):

- HSC English Studies (2 units)
- HSC General Maths 1 (2 units)
- HSC Computing Applications (1 unit)
- HSC Work Studies (1 unit)
- Preliminary Business Services (2 units Preliminary) leading to Certificate III qualification
- Preliminary Industry Based Learning (2 units Preliminary)
- Trade subject (2 units Preliminary) 1 day per week + commence apprenticeship 2 days per week

Total units HSC = 6 units + Preliminary = 4 units

Year 13 (Note: Fees based on the trade course + Trades Norwest courses):

- HSC Business Services (2 units) leading to Certificate III qualification
- HSC Industry Based Learning (2 units)

Note: Students will need to meet with Business Services teacher on a regular basis.

 HSC Trade subject (2 units) - 1 day per week + commence apprenticeship - 3/4 days per week

Total units HSC = 6 units

OUTCOME AT END OF YEAR 13

Students should be able to complete the following qualifications

- HSC
- Certificate II or Certificate III Business Services
- 1st year of apprenticeship

ADVANTAGES OF A PATHWAYS PROGRAM

Allows students to

- Make a late decision re starting a school-based apprenticeship
- Complete the HSC (with no HSC exams)
- Gain extra qualifications in Business Services
- Start working as an apprentice and earning money in Year 12
- Work almost full-time in Year 13
- Benefit from the support of College staff in early stages of apprenticeship
